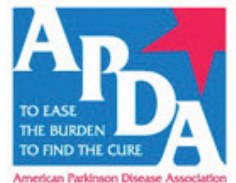


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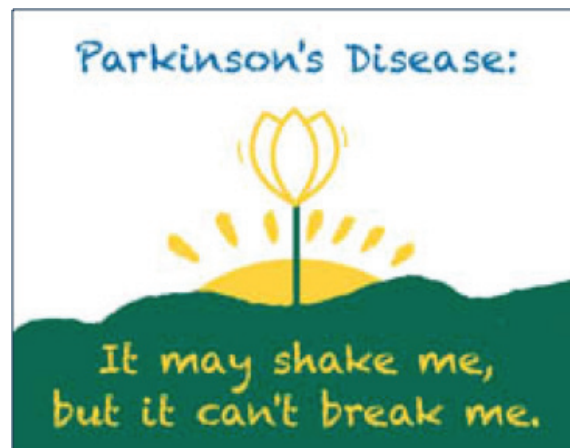

Approximately 60,000 people are diagnosed with PD *every year*.  
Parkinson's disease is more likely to occur in men than women.



Parkinson's Disease is a neurodegenerative disorder: the brain gradually stops producing the chemical **dopamine** which affects how we move.



Symptoms include: slowness of movement, soft speech, monotone voice, tremors, poor balance, and rigidity.

*Not everyone will experience the same symptoms: EACH CASE IS UNIQUE.*



Management includes: medications, physical therapy, occupational therapy, speech therapy.
